## Mike's Corner Soapbox

### Primary Jobs...

A few weeks ago, I wrote about whether or not an \$8.00 per hour job was a "primary job." Obviously, I don't think so, since the 2005 poverty level, as defined by HHS for a family of four, is \$9.30 per hour.

Even saying that our cost of living is lower than the average in the U.S., there are some spinoff effects of accepting \$8.00 an hour jobs as "primary".

One thing is that they cost us money. "Huh?," you may say.

Well, one of the things that happens is that people making \$8.00 an hour often can't afford to get health insurance through the company. So they're forced to tap into low-income health programs, such as Medicaid, which are paid for by taxpayers. In addition, they're eligible for Food Stamps and Energy Assistance, also paid for by (you guessed it) taxpayers.

One result of this is last week's action in Maryland, where the State House voted to override the Governor's veto of a bill requiring companies employing more than 10,000 people in the state to pay at least 8 percent of their salaries towards health insurance. Of the

four employers of more than 10,000 people, only Wal-Mart fails to meet the criteria. The reason? Only about 40% of Wal-Mart employees get health insurance through the company. Many of the employees simply can't afford the \$200 per month premium for a \$1,000 deductible policy.

Here's some other facts:

- In Alabama, 3,864 children of Wal-Mart employees cost state taxpayers between \$5.8 million and \$8.2 million for Medicaid coverage.

- In California, Wal-Mart workers rely on the state's taxpayers for about \$32 million annually in health-related services.

- In Tennessee, almost 10,000 Wal-Mart employees are on the State's expanded Medicaid program.

- In Georgia, more than 10,261 children of Wal-Mart employees are enrolled in the state's PeachCare program for health insurance for families meeting federal poverty criteria.

Now it may sound like I'm picking on Wal-Mart, but actually I'm just using them as an example of what happens when you believe that jobs paying less than the pov-

erty level are primary jobs. In reality, there's no hard and fast definition for "primary" jobs. In many circles, it's just considered to be full-time employment. In my mind, it should be defined more as one upon which a family can live without state assistance.

Don't get me wrong, there's nothing bad about \$8.00 per hour jobs. I just question whether or not we should be using economic development dollars to procure them.

I also question the whining heard from employers like "We can't find good people to work here," or that "the Pueblo education system is so bad we can't find qualified help."

I have news for them; if they were better educated they wouldn't be working for \$8.00 an hour anyway, at least not as a primary job. Maybe you've heard this one before; you get what ya pay for!

**New rules could fix gangster corporations**

The United States and another five of the world's greatest polluters have been meeting in Australia this past week. Attendance was very heavily dominated by coal producers. The theme of the meeting was to find ways to keep governments from mandating any restrictions on CO<sub>2</sub> pollution, which most scientists believe contributes to global warming. Australia is a huge coal exporter. It and the U.S. announced the establishment of a \$100 million fund to study ways that private industry might be able to reduce or store excess carbon dioxide derived from the burning of hydrocarbons. They expressed some hope that solutions to the problem might be found within a decade.



The U.S. Secretary of Energy attended. He was asked why he thought private industry would be willing to reduce CO<sub>2</sub> emissions voluntarily even though it would cost a lot more than ignoring the problem. He expressed conviction that the corporations' motivation would be good citizenship. He believes the businesses involved want to do the right thing for humanity.

The Secretary, like most conservatives, clings to the illusion that those who manage, control, and/or own for-profit corporations have such great integrity that they will do good for humanity even when it diminishes the profits and/or market positions of their firms. This may be marginally true, when it involves a relatively small donation for a community program such as United Way.

But these corporations exist for one purpose: profit. They, like the proverbial scorpion, cannot be what they are not ... and in the U.S., where radical capitalism is the rule, it is almost impossible for corporations to even postpone seizing short-term profits for a greater good down the road a few years. American corporations are compelled by their very nature to discount the value of long-term investment, especially if it involves the risks of exploring the unknown.

For example, American auto makers have for decades insisted that they cannot meet meaningful fuel-efficiency mandates. Their fear of true innovation has extended to designing new body types (on old frames) which will circumvent those mandates.

While the Yanks have stalled and cheated and lied, the Asian

auto makers (and even some European makers) proceeded with the research and development which enables them to surpass U.S. standards AND make profits, even when they produce their vehicles in the U.S.

In the American environment of Radical Capitalism, cheating has become the replacement for innovation, a buy-out is preferred to competition. Massive, intensive capitalization is favored only for quick profits, and that rules out risky, long-term R&D.

Mere humans serve these corporations. In this system, it is legal for competitors to destroy those companies which fail to return big short-term profits, even if they invest in long-term R&D which might contribute to the future common good.

This climate can only be changed by changing the rules of the game. U.S. corporations cannot do this.

Our government (that's us, through our representatives) constitutes the referees, the judges, the legislators needed to change the rule book so that long-term basic R&D can be conducted in the present for rewards far into the future. And in order that companies which move away from gangster tactics will not be punished for their good citizenship.

National mandates in concert with international treaties and trade pacts need to be part of the new rule book.

Our suspicion of international agreements (for instance, to eliminate the threat of weapons of mass destruction, to cope with global warming, to bring world criminals to justice, and to allow individuals to provide for their own families without harming others) — this paranoia of ours must cease.

When the U.S. pulls out of international arrangements, we are seen to be powerful despots with little or no regard for the well-being of humanity.

It is all too easy to believe this nation's power is in the hands of a cadre of callous pirates, gangsters who believe that might makes right. It may be true.

But as the balance of world power shifts in the next few years, most of these "gangster" radical capitalists (and those who allow them their power) will be at a loss to understand why the U.S. is without allies.

While the U.S. ignores the ugly disaster our hydrocarbon-fueled industrial juggernaut is wreaking around the globe, some other geopolitical group will find long-term, healthy alternatives ... and leave us in the lurch, another footnote in the history of greed, arrogance, and plunder. *jfh*

The more diverse and inclusive the stakeholder group, the better the chance that the complexities and complications of a site cleanup might be worked out for a sound environmental, economical and community result. Allan Comp, a renowned innovator in abandoned mine land reclamation in Pennsylvania's coal country and CU-Boulder Center of the American West staff member Timothy Brown also were co-authors of the report. The mission of the Center of the American West is to identify and address critical issues in the West and help Westerners become well-informed, participating citizens in their communities.
