Gas and hot air

Much is written about Americans' love for their automobiles and their per capita use of oil. Yep, we are the oil hogs of the world with a per capita use of about three gallons per day. Actually, we're about 17th out of all the countries in the world. Our total consumption is the most, but then again our population is twenty or more times higher than the countries ahead of us on the list. Another overlooked statistic is that our land area is twenty to fifty times as great as many of those other countries.

Now, I'm not apologizing for us; we actually have a fair amount of blame in the current oil crisis. After all, it was we who wanted to see the end of communism. It is America that is outsourcing thousands of jobs to countries where car ownership used to be a luxury. And it is we who are importing billions of dollars worth of goods from countries like China and Korea.

The new found wealth of these countries has greatly increased global demand for oil and plays a

significant role in the current shortages. Oil is a commodity based on supply and demand and these countries have made demand skyrocket.

On a more personal level, I'm using about one-third or more less gasoline than I was fifteen, twenty, or even thirty years ago. For one thing, our vehicles today are more fuel efficient than in the past. But I'm driving fewer miles, too. For many years, I averaged 18,000 or more miles per year. My commute to work was around half that amount. Today, I average around 12,000 miles per year.

This isn't caused by any great improvement in mass transportation or my walking to more places; it's just a matter of situation. But in reading several articles, it seems I'm in the minority when it comes to changes in driving habits. The trend is for people to be commuting farther to work, caused by both a desire to live in a smaller town and the fact that businesses have moved away from the heart of many cities. Mass transportation isn't as much of a viable alternative.

While it may irk me when Exxon-Mobil posts \$8 billion in profits, I understand the dynamics of that. While it may make great press for Congress to make all kinds of noise about that, the reality is that oil companies, just like any other business, mark up the costs of their products a certain percentage. So when the cost of oil jumps 40%, their profits go up about the same.

So instead of our Congress making a lot of noise, maybe they should get off their duffs and do something. Failing that, maybe we can bottle up all their hot air; it could probably provide enough energy to fuel a small city! Plus, we'd get some value for the salaries we pay them, other than political rhetoric.
