A first lie requires another and another to justify the first. And the first killing based on a lie seems to necessitate more killing to justify it and the lie that inspired it.

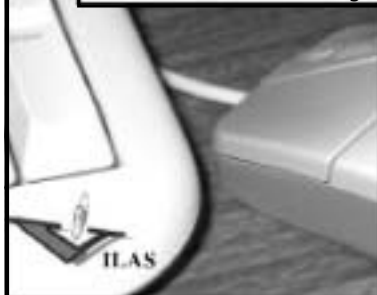
