New Liberty Bell 'forever' stamp goes on sale at post offices

USPS 4/11 – Who says nothing lasts forever? Here's your chance to purchase a one-ounce First Class Stamp that will always last forever. No need to purchase those penny cent stamps for First-Class one ounce letter postage increases in the future.

The new 41-cent "Forever" Stamp is available at all post offices as of Thursday, April 12. The Forever Stamp will always be available at the price of a First-Class Mail stamp in effect at the time of purchase. To introduce the stamp to the public, the Postal Service is offering the Forever Stamp at 41 cents.

Customers can purchase and start using the Forever Stamp now, even though stamp prices will not change from their current 39 cents to the new 41-cents one-ounce letter rate until May 14. When prices change in the future, the Forever Stamp will sell at the new one-ounce, single-piece First-Class Mail price.

There are no limits on customer purchases. Beginning April 12, customers have been able to purchase the new Forever Stamp in a variety of ways. The Forever Stamp is available in booklets, priced at \$8.20 for a booklet of 20 stamps, at post office retail counters and at select post office vending machines nationwide.

Effective May 14, customers can also purchase the Forever Stamps in sheetlets of 18 stamps, priced at \$7.38 each, at self-service Automated Postal Centers, located in over 2500 postal lobbies nationwide, and at select ATMs that offer stamps. Also, many participating convenience stores, grocery stores, drug stores and other retailers will also begin selling Forever Stamps in booklets of 20.

Four billion of the new Forever Stamps have been printed and are available nationwide as of April 12. That includes over 5.5 million Forever Stamps in Colorado and Wyoming, and two million Forever Stamps in Montana.

The Forever Stamp, which shows a picture of the historic Liberty Bell, was dedicated Thursday morning, April 12, in a special press ceremony in Philadelphia at the museum site where the original Liberty Bell is housed for public viewing.

CSU/Pueblo to signal switch to renewable energy at solar panel dedication April 26

CSU/Pblo 4/20 – Colorado State University-Pueblo, in conjunction with Smart Growth Advocates (SGA), EcoSol, TC Associates, Aquila power company, and the Southeastern Colorado Renewable Energy Society will symbolically make the “switch” to renewable energy as part of a dedication of new solar photovoltaic panels south of the University’s Technology Building at 9 a.m. on Thursday, April 26. Aquila created a switch that will represent the start of a renewable energy commitment at the University.

CSU/Pblo Pres. Joseph Garcia will preside at this groundbreaking installation. Solar panels, two arrays with a total of 36 modules rated at 6.12 KW, will be located on the south side of CSU-Pueblo’s Technology Building, adjacent to the Buell Communications Center (KTSC-

TV). An educational kiosk, adjacent to the solar panels, will provide general information on solar photovoltaic technology. Public access to the educational kiosk will be available during the day to be used by area schools as a field trip destination.

“We are delighted by the energetic collaboration with CSU -P, Eco Sol, Aquila and SECRES to provide tangible educational opportunities in renewable energy,” Vickie Massam, SGA President. “The pole mounted modules outside the Technology building with the kiosk and state of the art web interface will provide real time data on the benefits of renewable energy.”

Along with educating the community on solar energy, the Solar Photovoltaic Project will provide CSU-Pueblo students

with an applied work experience as they will regularly calculate, calibrate, and measure the system’s output and efficiency. CSU-Pueblo Engineering graduate and undergraduate students will conduct research on all aspects of solar electricity generation through the project. The installation includes a web interface which captures live data. Computer Information Systems students will be engaged to create graphical outputs to monitor electricity produced, cost saving, and other measurable data, on the CSU-Pueblo website.

“This installation will be an important lab for our students and is an important first step in moving CSU-Pueblo to dependence only on renewable resources,” said Jane M. Fraser, CSU-Pueblo professor and chair of engineering.
