What they aren't saying...

Inexorably, the Presidential election process grinds on. Now that the Florida primary has given Republican John McCain the lead over Mitt Romney, with Giuliani, Thompson, Huckabee and Paul either out or way down, only Romney's ability to finance his own campaign keeps the GOP nomination up in the air til Super Tuesday, Feb. 5.

Obama and Hillary are the remaining combatants on the Democrat side for Super Tuesday. This has been the year for Senators (and a couple Congressmen) to aspire to the nomination in both parties. Romney and Huckabee entered the race with gubernatorial credentials.

Debate on both sides revolves mostly around war (in Iraq and Afghanistan), homeland security, illegal immigration, and the flagging economy. No leading candidate says

much about global warming, corruption in banking, creeping corporatism, or the Bush-Cheney usurpation of powers never designated in the Constitution for the Executive Branch.

One suspects the usurpation of powers question gets no airing because all the candidates (except Paul) secretly delight in the prospect of using these illegal powers if they themselves become President. It seems that any person with the ego to think he or she is fit to be President wants also to ignore Congress and the Supreme Court, just as Bush and Cheney have.

Bush has attached over 1,000 signing statements to bills he has signed, averring that he will ignore these bills because he is not subject to the will of Congress, especially as long as he can drag on his pet War on Terror, which al-

lows him to pretend anything he chooses to do is an act of the Commander in Chief of the military and, by extension, of the entire government as it supports the military. So much for extra-legal powers.

They don't want to talk about the collapse of the bundled-mortgage bond market because none of them is sure yet which of the giant Wall Street financiers' backing he or she might need between now and November. This is also the reason none of the leading candidates is willing to take on CORPORATISM, that system of representative government promulgated by the Heritage Foundation, the Independence Institute, and every President since and including Ronald Reagan.

Domestic corporatism was nurtured to its poisonous zenith by the Republican Congress between 1998 and 2006, requiring giant corporations and industrial groups to do-

nate heavily to Republican campaigns (while withholding donations from the Democrats) and in exchange for this, they were given carte blanche participation in the creation of legislation favoring their interests. Thus, under Republican corporatism, the Congress represented corporations instead of American citizens. We know why the GOP candidates don't want to talk about this, but why, we wonder, have the Democrats been so quiet? Could it be that Hillary and Obama are real cozy with the corporatists, too?

Super Tuesday is going to reveal who from among Clinton, Obama, McCain, and Romney will forge ahead in their respective nomination contests. But we have eight more months to weed out the power-mongers and the corporatists. Who among these can say they are truly for a reformation of the stinking way we have been governed? jfh



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
