Of course all of these items had to be placed on the ballot long before the economy hit the skids. I'm disappointed that the school district bond didn't pass; it was an infrastructure project that would pay off down the road. But again, it wasn't a surprise.

It's time to move forward and make the best of these tough times. Pueblo is a resilient community with a lot of good people and we're looking good compared to many other parts of the country. If we continue to work together, we can keep Pueblo a great place to live!

America's Future: Meeting the Needs of a Changing America

Now that the election is over and Democrats are vested with control of the presidency and the Congress, it would be a mistake to let the euphoria of the huge Democratic victory—a mandate if you will—give way to the hazards of operating the Congress and legislating in a way that is devoid of popular consent. The American public can be convinced of the virtue of Democratic domestic and foreign policy, but our representatives must be committed to serving both as the public voice and trustees of the public interest, and always being cognizant of the will of the people. Trust is the hard currency here. But trust can yield Democratic solutions to difficult issues. There is no better place for debate of the major issues of our time, and to do so openly, honestly, and thoroughly, than in Congress, the people's branch. Here's how our representatives can meet the needs of a changing America:

Fight for people: Empowering people with education, jobs that pay real wages, and accessible and affordable health care—all of these are the life blood of economic prosperity. Incidentally, these are the best inoculation against poverty, hunger and crime, too.

Fight for our land, air and water: We are stewards of our vast and varied natural resources. And in southern Colorado, we are particularly sensitive to protecting our water. Productive land for our farms, clean air to breath, abundant and clean water, alternative and renewable forms of energy, and a commitment to stop global warming will assure our children, our children's children and all future generations the quality of life we enjoy.

Fight for the rights and safety of people: The American people face grave new challenges—demands for a united front against global terrorism suggest a precarious balance between security and freedom. It is precisely these times that require us to guard our civil rights and liberties. Congress can be the engine of democracy in these uncertain times. It must rally the political courage to be an effective check on unlimited presidential power and authority.

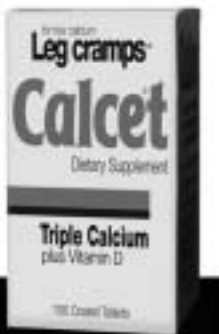
