Upgrades Begin on State Highway 160

CDOT 7/23)— Work is underway to improve the 18 mile segment of U.S. 160 between mile 405 and 423, east and west of Kim.

The Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) project consists of rotomilling, asphalt paving, full-depth patching at select locations, new guardrails, traffic delineators and striping. In addition, the 56-year-old bridge at Smith Canyon is being replaced with a concrete box culvert. It is located about seven miles west of Kim.

Project hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday. During paving operations, drivers can expect single lane closures, with alternating traffic through the work zone. Delays up to 15 minutes should be anticipated.

Beginning on Friday, August 7, Highway 160 will be closed 24/7 to all through traffic, except emergency vehicles, for bridge replacement. A local traffic detour will be in place, southwest of Kim, using the follow-

ing county roads, east to west: 185, 30, and 191.

The closure and detour route are expected to remain in place for about 10 days, with the highway reopened to traffic by Sunday, August 16.

All through traffic will be required to detour around this area, using these recommended routes:

—WEST TO EAST – From the Trinidad area: northeast on U.S. 350 to La Junta, south on State Highway 109 to Kim OR east on U.S. 50 from La Junta to Lamar,

and south on U.S. 287 to U.S. 160 in Springfield.

—EAST TO WEST – From the Springfield area: west on Highway 160 to SH 109, north on SH 109 to La Junta, southwest on U.S. 350 to Trinidad OR if headed to Pueblo, or points west or north, travel north on U.S. 287 from Springfield to Lamar, west on U.S. 50 to Pueblo.

APC Southern Construction of is the contractor for the \$4.8 million project. It is scheduled for completion in November 2015.

U.S. Postal Service may be asking about rural mail service

NNA 7/23)—Small towns and rural areas may soon get more attention from the U.S. Postal Service, following several years of post office and mail sorting facility closings. The Senate Appropriations Committee this week ordered new examination of the on-time arrival of mail outside urban areas. National Newspaper Association President John Edgecombe Jr., publisher of The Nebraska Signal in Geneva, NE, said the new requirement resulted from NNA's work to improve rural mail service. He expressed NNA's thanks to Sen. Roy Blunt, R-MO, for being the champion of a new rural mail service measurement. Blunt said, "Rural mail delivery has been increasingly strained in recent years, especially with additional mail processing center closures in my state. Many rural Missourians have experienced delayed mail, and it is a problem that needs to be addressed. I am pleased the Appropriations Committee included my language directing

the Postal Service and Postal Regulatory Commission to work together to create a measurement to determine rural mail delivery times. With the U.S. Postal Service expressing support for this language, this is a constructive step forward to address the ongoing challenges facing rural mail service."

CSU-Pueblo SSS student support funds renewed

CSU-P 7/21) – The federally funded Student Support Services (SSS) program at Colorado State University-Pueblo has been renewed for \$1.4 million over the next five years to provide services that increase the college success of students who are low income, first generation, or disabled. The U.S. Department of Education will provide just over \$300,000 in the first year of the grant (09/01/2015-08/31/2016), which will provide academic and other support services to 220 SSS program participants to increase their retention and graduation rates and to foster an institutional climate supportive of their success.
