Distracted driving crashes on the rise in Colorado

CDOT 3/31) — There were an estimated 15,307 distracted driving crashes in Colorado in 2015, a number that has grown by 16 percent in the last four years. In 2012 there were 13,236 distracted driving crashes; in 2013 there were 14,002; and in 2014 there were 14,753. With these troubling statistics in mind, the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) and Colorado State Patrol (CSP) are joining a national effort in recognizing April as National Distracted Driving Awareness Month by declaring distracted driving a significant threat to traffic safety in Colorado. Preliminary data indicates that 69 people were killed in distracted driving crashes in 2015, up from 59 in 2014.

“In a recent CDOT survey, 25 percent of Colorado drivers admitted to using their cell phones for messaging, 38 percent talked on a hand-held cell phones, 63 percent used entertainment devices and 41 percent had eaten while driving in the previous week,” said Darrell Lingk, Director of the CDOT's Office of Transportation Safety. “It's clear distracted driving poses a threat to anyone on Colorado roadways, and it's an issue that CDOT will attack head on this summer through our Drop the Distraction campaign.”

Of the estimated 57,298 distracted driving crashes in Colorado between 2012 and 2015, drivers 21 to 30 years old were involved in 30 percent of the crashes. Furthermore, drivers 31 to 40 years old were the second largest group of distracted drivers, accounting for 18 percent of distracted driving crashes be-

tween 2012 and 2015. The most common distraction in these crashes were cell phones followed closely by other passengers in the vehicle. More than 50 percent of Colorado's distracted driving crashes from 2012 to 2015 occurred in Denver, Jefferson, Arapahoe and Adams counties.

“We know we can save lives by reducing the number of impaired drivers on the road and increasing seat belt usage, which is the reason for our DUI and seat belt enforcement periods,” said Scott Hernandez, Chief of the Colorado State Patrol. “Distracted driving is a more recent, but equally dangerous driving habit, and one that we hope to impact through our next enforcement period.”

In conjunction with Distracted Driving National Awareness Month, CDOT is partnering with CSP to conduct a high-visibility distracted driving enforcement period. Beginning Friday, April 8, and running through Sunday, April 10, state troopers will increase patrols, specifically looking for drivers who are distracted.

CDOT is also asking Facebook users to submit their own anti-distracted driving messages for possible use on highway message signs throughout the state. Starting Thursday, March 31, the CDOT Facebook page will begin accepting user submissions for messages, and will then put the submission to a public vote. The winning messages may be displayed on highway signs in April. This summer, CDOT will launch a high-visibility campaign to decrease distracted driving.

Science team thinks Indonesian 'hobbits' gone 50,000 years

Smithson 3/30) — Eight years of further excavations and study at the Indonesian cave site of Liang Bua have pushed back the time of disappearance of the "hobbits" of Flores (*Homo floresiensis*) from as recently as 12,000 years ago to about 50,000 years ago—around the same time that modern humans first dispersed through the wider region and reached Australia. The new findings are reported by Smithsonian scientist Matt Tocheri and an international team of researchers in the journal *Nature*.

In 2003, archaeologists uncovered the remains of a human skeleton roughly 6 meters (20 feet) beneath the present-day surface of Liang Bua. The skull revealed an extremely small, chimpanzee-sized brain (about 400 centimeters, cubed) and the limb bones showed that this fully grown adult would have stood about 106 centimeters (3.5 feet) tall. In overall appearance, it was most similar to fossil human species that lived in Africa and Asia between 1 and 3 million years ago. This new member of the human family tree, called *H. floresiensis* and dubbed the "hobbit," was first reported to the world in *Nature* Oct. 28, 2004.

The skeleton was initially thought to be about 18,000 years old, with fragmentary remains of other individuals found in older and younger layers thought to have been deposited between 95,000 and 12,000 years ago. The surprisingly recent age for the disappearance of *H. floresiensis* implied that this diminutive human species had survived on Flores almost 40 millennia after modern humans first passed through this island archipelago, reaching Australia by around 50,000 years ago.

New excavations were carried out at the Indonesian site from 2007 to 2014 by researchers from the Smithsonian Institution in the United States, the National Research Centre for Archaeology in Indonesia

and the University of Wollongong in Australia and revealed a stratigraphic sequence far more complex than originally thought. New dates for the site show that all of the skeletal remains of *H. floresiensis* are between about 100,000 and 60,000 years old, with stone artifacts likely made by this species continuing to about 50,000 years ago. Modern humans were venturing through the islands of Southeast Asia around this time, but whether the two species ever encountered each other on Flores or elsewhere is currently unknown.

H. floresiensis is not the only species that suddenly disappears from the Liang Bua stratigraphic sequence about 50,000 years ago. "Vultures, g-

ant marabou storks, an extinct relative of elephants and even Komodo dragons vanish from the sequence with *H. floresiensis*,” said co-lead author Matt Tocheri, Human Origins Program research associate at the Smithsonian’s National Museum of Natural History and Canada Research Chair in Human Origins at Lakehead University. “Our new understanding of the last appearance date of *H. floresiensis* and these associated animals raises new exciting questions. Lots of people may have interesting ideas about why these taxa disappear together 50,000 years ago, but the truth is that we don’t know precisely why—and we won’t know with any certainty until much more work is done at

Liang Bua and other sites on Flores.”

Lead author of the study, Thomas Sutikna at the University of Wollongong and National Research Centre for Archaeology, said, “We didn’t realize during our original excavations that the ‘hobbit’ deposits near the eastern wall of the cave were similar in age to those near the cave center, which we had dated to about 74,000 years ago. As we extended our original excavations each year, it became increasingly clear that there was a large remnant pedestal of older deposits truncated by an erosional surface that sloped steeply toward the cave mouth.”

This erosional surface was later covered by much younger sediments during the past

20,000 years. “Unfortunately, the ages of these overlying sediments were originally thought to apply to the ‘hobbit’ remains, but our continuing excavations and analyses revealed that this was not the case,” said co-author Wahyu Saptomo, head of conservation and archaeometry at the National Research Centre for Archaeology.

Professor Richard “Bert” Roberts, Australian Research Council Laureate Fellow at the University of Wollongong, oversaw the various dating analyses used in the study. “We dated charcoal, sediments, flowstones, volcanic ash and even the *H. floresiensis* bones themselves using the most up-to-date scientific methods available. In the last decade, we’ve vastly improved our under-

standing of when the deposits accumulated in Liang Bua, and what this means for the age of ‘hobbit’ bones and stone tools. But whether ‘hobbits’ encountered modern humans or other groups of humans—such as the ‘Denisovans’—dispersing through Southeast Asia remains an open and intriguing question.”

Other members of the research team included Jatmiko, Sri Wasisto and the late Rokus Due Awe at the National Research Centre for Archaeology; Bo Li, Mike Morley, Tony Dosseto, Gerrit van den Bergh and the late Mike Morwood at the University of Wollongong; Kira Westaway at the Macquarie University; Max Aubert, Rainer Grün and Adam Brumm at Griffith University; Jian-xin Zhao

at the University of Queensland; Michael Storey at the Natural History Museum of Denmark; Brent Alloway at the Victoria University of Wellington; Hanneke Meijer at the University Museum of Bergen; and Bill Jungers at Stony Brook University.

Dear EarthTalk: How is it that big game hunting can actually be good for wildlife?

—Ronnie Wilson, Ft. Myers, FL

WHEN MINNESOTA dentist Walter Palmer killed Cecil, a much-loved wild 13-year-old black-maned lion, with his bow and arrow in July 2015 outside a protected section of Zimbabwe's Hwange National Park, animal advocates were outraged. The University of Oxford's Wildlife Conservation Research Unit team had been studying Cecil and his family—protected as long as they stayed within the invisible borders of the park—at the time. In response to the extensive media coverage and public fury following the incident, Delta, American and United airlines announced in August that they would no longer allow hunters to transport big game trophies, including buffalo, elephant, leopard, lion or rhino, on their flights.

Cecil's death also helped draw attention to big game hunting and its effects on wildlife populations and their ecosystems. Globe-trotting big game hunters imported more than 1.26 million "trophies"—the part of the animal they keep for display—to the U.S. between 2005 and 2014, according to a new report by Humane

Society International (HSI). That's an average of 126,000 trophy imports a year, or 345 a day.

But hunting proponents found the sudden backlash over Cecil's death unsubstantiated. Dr. Alan Maki, conservation chair at the prominent hunting group, Safari Club International (SCI), argued that, considering that Africa's human population is projected to double to two billion in the next 25 years, more and more land will be needed to support this growth, resulting in lots of lost wildlife habitat. Safari hunting, a \$200 million annual industry, provides substantial value to wildlife, he said, by paying for anti-poaching patrols, national park operations and conservation programs that support local communities.

"We're too busy showing everyone what great hunters we are, and we're not doing enough to show what kind of conservationists we are," says Ivan Carter, an African hunting guide and host of Carter's W.A.R. on the Outdoor Channel. "We have to change the perception that we are just trophy killers and we've got to focus on the fact that we're conservationists, and we do that by having and sharing the right information and research, and taking the time to post properly on social media."

Of course, not everyone

agrees that trophy hunting is benign, let alone beneficial. HSI maintains that widespread corruption in some of Africa's most sought after big game destinations means that money raised from trophy hunting in places like Tanzania and Zimbabwe is more likely used to line officials' pockets than to help ailing wildlife populations. (This unavoidable corruption was part of the reason Kenya banned trophy hunting altogether within its borders some four decades ago.) HSI also points out that trophy hunting may be more about ego-stroking than conservation, with wealthy American hunters willing to pay top dollar to compete in contests to kill the most wildlife for awards (such as the "Africa Big Five" that includes lions, elephants, rhinos, leopards and Cape buffalo).

HSI, which has published several reports detailing the negative effects of trophy hunting on wildlife populations, is working to get additional airlines to refuse passage to hunting trophies, and has helped introduce legislation to Congress calling for a ban on the importation of large animal trophies altogether.

While it appears that the debate is not going to be settled anytime soon, animal advocates maintain that upholding laws protecting species does much more to protect animals than killing them ever can. •

CU-Boulder study finds:

Atmospheric nitrogen leads to loss of plant diversity in many U.S. sites

CUBouldr 3/28)—Rising levels of atmospheric nitrogen pollution threaten plant diversity at nearly one-quarter of sites across a widespread portion of the U.S., according to a new study led by University of Colorado Boulder researchers.

The findings, which were published today in the journal *Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences*, are the first to examine ecosystem-specific vulnerabilities to atmospheric nitrogen pollution on a continental scale.

Nitrogen plays an important role in biological processes and makes up a key element of fertilizer, but previous research has shown that it is possible for plants to get too much of a good thing. Global emissions of nitrogen to the atmosphere have tripled in the last century due to agriculture and industry, and elevated levels of nitrogen have been shown to cause environmental damage, including decreased plant species richness in experimental plots.

The study examined more than 15,000 forest, woodland, shrubland and grassland sites across the country, measuring the threshold at which nitrogen inputs become harmful to plants while also taking other environmental factors such as climate and soil conditions into account.

In all, 24 percent of the sites surveyed were at or above levels that result in plant species losses, with grassland regions (especially those with acidic soil) being most vulnerable. Groundcover plant species in forested regions with neutral pH soil were found to be the least vulnerable.

The findings may have wide-ranging implications for future air quality standards and biodiversity conservation efforts. Air pollution, along with habitat loss, is a major factor implicated in the loss of plant diversity across the U.S.

"The numerous plant species that live in an ecosystem are a bit like rivets on an airplane," said Samuel Simkin, a post-doctoral research associate in the Institute of Arctic and Alpine Research (INSTAAR) at CU-Boulder and lead author of the new study. "You might be able to lose a few without issue, but losing too many can be disastrous. It's hard to determine where that tipping point is."

"Plant species diversity acts as an ecological buffer against events such as drought," said William Bowman, a professor in the Department of Ecology and Evolutionary Biology at CU-Boulder and a co-author of the study. "If we see a reduction in plant species in some ecosystems as a result of atmospheric

nitrogen, that might lead to unintended consequences and affect communities adversely."

The study was co-authored by Edith Allen of the University of California Riverside; Christopher Clark of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency; Jayne Belnap, Matthew Brooks and Brian Cade of the U.S. Geological Survey; Scott Collins of the University of New Mexico; Linda Geiser, Sarah Jovan, Linda Pardo and Bethany Schulz of the U.S. Forest Service; Frank Gilliam of Marshall University; Carly Stevens of Lancaster University; Katharine Suding of the University of Colorado Boulder; Heather Throop of Arizona State University; and Donald Walter of the University of Wisconsin.

The research is a product of the U.S. Geological Survey John Wesley Powell Center for Analysis and Synthesis. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the Cooperative Ecosystem Studies Units Network and the U.S. Geological Survey provided funding for the research. Additional support was provided by the U.S. Forest Service; the ESA Vegbank; the Minnesota DNR Biological Survey Program; the New York, Virginia and West Virginia Natural Heritage Programs; the Carolina Vegetation Survey; the National Park Service; and the University of Wisconsin Plant Ecology Lab. •
